Principal's News



Dear Parents,

Two weeks till the end of second term and isn't time flying.

We started the term with two big changes in the school. The first was moving the Uniform Shop which was not an easy task and without the assistance of Tracey and Lyric it would have been a nightmare. You can now purchase new uniforms from Nell Grey in Joondalup or online, however we will still be selling second hand uniforms at the front office. The second big change was the loss of Rawlie Bites as our canteen provider. We were lucky enough to discover Lunch Box Hub and the transition to have them supply lunches for our students has been seamless. Lunches have arrived every day on time and beautifully made. The choice is varied, and I have had only one complaint from one student who said that there wasn't enough. Our student councillors have been superb in distributing the food into class baskets and delivery to classes has all been done within 10 minutes of the food arriving. Outstanding by everyone.

Something that was asked for in our last parent survey was the opportunity to have Parent/Teacher Interviews. This term we engaged a program called School Interviews that enabled parents to book in to see their child's teacher and discuss how they are going at school. We put aside a day, Friday 27th June, for this to happen, from 11.40am, currently we have 151 families that have booked in and 200 parent interviews taking place. A few teachers are fully booked but most still have times that you can reserve if you are able.

The last two weeks of term are busy.

- School Photos – Monday June 30th and Wednesday July 2nd. The schedule for photos has been sent out on Dojo so that you know when your child needs to be in School Uniform.
- Student Golf Clinic 2 – Thursday, July 3rd.
- Cross Country – Rawlinson Primary School Cross Country – Friday July 4th – 9.00am till 11.00am – subject to the weather.

Literacy

Literacy at Rawlinson

Handwriting

Every Pre-Primary to Year 6 classroom completes formal handwriting lessons for at least 10 minutes per day.

What does this look like in our classrooms?

- The early childhood classrooms complete handwriting as part of their phonics program. They introduce the letters in the order outlined by the PLD phonics program, using a consistent language.
- The Kindy to Year 1 classrooms also complete regular fine motor tasks to build hand and finger strength and hand-eye coordination. These skills help the students with pencil grip and letter formation.
- From Year 3, students learn to write with joined letters.

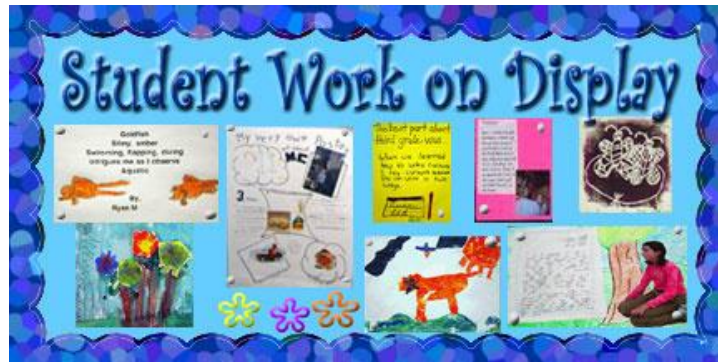

Health Tips :

Bike Safety

Riding a bike is great fun and good exercise for children and teens. Here are a few tips to keep your children safe while cycling.

- Children under 10 should be supervised when riding a bike.
- Children should be taught the rules of the road before they ride by themselves.
- Riding in the driveway should not be encouraged. Children need to know that the driveway is dangerous. Teach them to stop at the end of the driveway, look, listen and think about whether it is safe to cross the road.
- Every child needs a helmet that fits correctly. Helmets should be worn at all times when riding. Parents should set a good example by wearing a helmet themselves.
- Children's bicycles should be kept in a good condition and have the appropriate reflectors.
- Children should wear bright coloured clothing when riding.
