Health Tips : Immunisation

Immunisation helps to protect your children and the community from serious infectious diseases.

Children can receive free immunisations at GP clinics, local immunisation clinics, Aboriginal community health services or the Central Immunisation Clinic. Each immunisation is recorded in the Australian Immunisation Register. You can obtain your child's immunisation history statement through your online Medicare account via [myGov](#), the [Medicare Express Plus app](#), at a Medicare Service Centre, by calling on 1800 653 809, or contacting their immunisation provider. This record is needed for school enrolment.

Please ensure your school-aged child is fully immunised. An up-to-date immunisation status is required to be eligible for family assistance payments and kindergarten enrolment.

If your child misses immunisations, or you have concerns, please talk with the School Health Nurse, Child and Family Health Nurse, General Practitioner or Paediatrician.

- 👉 Detailed design for traffic signals is progressing well.
 - 👉 Expecting final approval from Western Power and Main Roads WA by September 2026.
 - 👉 Construction on traffic signals & improvement to slip lanes is expected between January - June 2027.
 - 👉 More definitive timeframes will be shared in the coming months.
- At last, this intersection will receive the funding & capital works it needs to improve safety & reduce vehicle crashes.

The WA Planning Commission has approved development application for the Marangaroo Golf Course. Our local public course will be upgraded to include:
